

2021 ENROLLMENT AGREEMENT

APPLICATION DETAILS

- The camps are open to boys and girls of good character. We reserve the right to accept or reject applicants. Spiritually, our camps are Christian, however, we endeavor to maintain a cross section of the very best of American Life in balance with the best interests of all camp participants.
- Filing application implies understanding, by camper and parents, of our policy that there shall be no smoking, vaping, chewing tobacco, drinking of alcoholic beverages, or possession of or use of illicit drugs during the camp session. We reserve the right to dismiss any camper whose action, attitude, behavior or words, in our judgment, is contrary to the best interests of camp.
- Enrollment is limited in some session lengths, based on age/grade and spaces available, especially in some of the shorter-term camp sessions. Waiting lists are accepted in all camp sessions.
- We practice safety at all times, to the best of our ability; however, participation in camp life and activities has inherent risks and injuries sometimes do occur. With enrollment, parents acknowledge and accept this fact and agree to hold harmless the camps, its employees, and agents against any and all claims, damages and injuries.
- A resident medical staff is available for routine medical services, but the cost of special medications, illness expenses, hospital costs, or consulting doctors are not included in the camp fee.
- We cannot be responsible for clothing, watches, jewelry, electronics or other personal property brought to camp. We will deposit any valuables in our camp safe if turned over to us upon arrival. We highly recommend the use of name tapes for marking all clothing and gear.
- Camp preparation materials, including our Parent Handbook, clothing/equipment lists, medical forms, shipping tags and transportation information will be sent in early spring. Applicants accepted after any of these mailing dates will receive these materials along with the letter of acceptance.
- A successful camping experience and partnership with parents is the result of mutual confidence and cooperation. We pledge you our best and ask that you cooperate with us in terms of supplying information requested and honoring camper and parent expectations as outlined in our Parent Handbook.

 - Intro:** A fun and structured introduction to the camp experience. Available for boys and girls who are currently in kindergarten through 2nd grade.
 - Ten Day Camp:** A short term traditional camp experience. Available for boys and girls who are currently in 2nd through 9th grades.
 - 2 Weeks 1-2:** A opportunity to experience first-hand the benefits of the traditional camp experience. Available for boys and girls who are currently in 2nd through 6th grades. ***Due to Covid-19, 2 Week Sessions 1 and 2 are available to campers currently in 6th grade.
 - 2 Weeks 3-4:** An opportunity to experience first-hand the benefits of traditional camp experience. Available for boys who are currently in 2nd through 5th grades and for girls who are currently in 2nd through 4th grades.
 - 4 Weeks /LT:** The classic camp experience. Available for boys and girls who are currently in 2nd through 12th grades. Due to Covid-19, the LT Programs at both camps are available to those who were to be LTs in Summer 2020.
- The application and deposit constitute an enrollment agreement only when accepted by a Camp Lincoln and Camp Lake Hubert Director in writing and shall be construed in and under the laws of the State of Minnesota. Any controversy or claim arising out of or relating to this enrollment agreement or the breach thereof which cannot be resolved in accordance with the terms hereof shall be filed with and settled by the American Arbitration Association's Minnesota Regional Office in accordance with the then existing Rules of the American Arbitration Association, and any award rendered by the arbitrator or arbitrators may be entered in either the District Court of Crow Wing County, Minnesota, or the United States Court, District of Minnesota. This agreement shall be construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Minnesota. We consider your enrollment and/or payment as acknowledgement and acceptance of all the terms of this agreement.
- It is understood by parents and campers that any video, portraits or pictures of the camper taken at camp and quotes or other written materials may be used by Camp Lincoln and Camp Lake Hubert or their assigned agents for art, advertising and promotional information. Parents and campers waive the right to inspect and/or approve the finished product or copy. A list of camper names and addresses may be distributed for camper's use.

A \$75.00 Daily Fee for any interim days will be added to the fee for campers combining sessions. Payment Plan Options are outlined on our webpage under Payments, Cancellations and Expense Deposit.

No reduction of tuition is made for late arrival, early departure or dismissal. Early departure and late arrivals must be approved by camp directors prior to camp season. Cancellation Fees are not reduced for medical reasons.

Multiple Sibling Discount: For those families enrolling more than one child in one of our traditional camps, we are pleased to offer a \$50 discount for each subsequent sibling enrolled.

Deposit for Miscellaneous Expenditures: An expense deposit is required in addition to the camp tuition. This deposit payment is required in advance, to serve as a drawing account for the camper. The first statement will invoice the estimated deposit for expenditures for the session in camp, i.e.

\$300.00 for 4 Week Sessions \$250.00 for 2 Week Sessions \$150.00 for Intro Session

Items charged against this account when applicable: camp store items; local and special trips; chartered bus to/from Minneapolis/St. Paul Airport; laundry; yearbook; bedding; medical prescriptions and illness expense. Campers who participate in some of our special trips (kayaking, rafting, chartered sailing, climbing, etc.) can expect an additional charge per trip which could cause expenses to exceed the recommended deposit.

Only those services actually used or items purchased will be charged and any balance remaining will be refunded or overdraft will be billed in Late September.

TRANSPORTATION

We coordinate air travel arrangements through Travel One (1-800-245-1111). All campers are met at their gate upon arrival at the Minneapolis/St. Paul Airport. Chartered bus service to and from camp for all airport campers is provided at a nominal charge. Chartered bus service is also available at a nominal charge from a Minneapolis Suburban Location for local campers.

If flying, please plan arrival at the Minneapolis/St. Paul Airport

between 9:00 am and 2:00 pm on Opening Days and

departure between NOON and 4:00 pm on Closing Days.

Requests to arrive or depart outside of these times, or on days other than the scheduled arrival and/or departure day, will need the prior approval of a Camp Director. Camp Director Approval is also needed if you wish to pick up your camper for an event during the camp session. Please submit requests at your earliest convenience, and at least 30 days prior to the camp session. Failure to gain approval may cause the cancellation of the registration, subject to our cancellation policy.

Check-Out: Between 8:00 am – 11:00 am on Closing Day
